As we begin preparations for the 2021-2022 school year, we need your help. First, if you have not yet completed registration for the next school year, please do so immediately! You can go into the Skyward Parent Portal to complete this task. Also, if you have moved within the past year, are renting, or are hosted by another family, you will need to complete the annual residency paperwork. This is due August 1st and is critical to our scheduling process so that we have accurate information about our families and accurate counts of students in classes before we start the school year. After we have completed our data meetings with the elementary buildings, we will begin building our schedule for the upcoming school year. Typically, this process is completed by mid-July and schedules are made available to those who have completed registration and residency documents. More information will be made available to families after the beginning of June.

Thank you all for your continued support of our school and our school district. We are truly fortunate to have a strong, committed community here at Prairie Knolls Middle School and we look forward to finishing 2020-2021 strong. GO FALCONS!!

Annual Residency Verification

If you already have a student in grades EC-12th grade and currently own and reside at your residence in Skyward you are not required to prove residency. If you have moved, you will need to contact the office and complete a new residency verification form and submit the required documentation to prove your residency. Families that rent or are hosted are required to complete residency paperwork annually. Residency verification for the 2021-2022 school year will begin on May 1st.

IMPORTANT NOTE - Verification of Residency is due before August 1st. Students who have not completed the residency paperwork by the start of school will be excluded.

News from the Nurse



- All 6th graders have a Dental Exam requirement **due by May 15th, 2021**. Dental exams need to have been completed between 11/15/19-5/15/21. You can find the Illinois State Dental Exam form on our website at <https://central301.net/health-services/health-requirements/>. Forms may be submitted any time. Please email the nurse at lauren.sak@central301.net with any questions.
- If your 6th grade student has not completed and submitted their required physical and immunizations for the 2020-21 school year, it **must be submitted before your student may return for in-person learning**.
- Here is a list of school health exams that will be due for students entering these grades for the 2021-22 school year. These forms should be submitted before your student starts school in August.
 - Physical Exams: Early Childhood, Kindergarten, 6th Grade, and 9th Grade
 - Immunizations: Early Childhood, Kindergarten, 6th Grade, 12th grade
 - Dental Exams: Kindergarten, 2nd Grade, 6th Grade, and 9th Grade
 - Eye Exams: Kindergarten
 - If your student has a medical condition that may require nursing support and/or medications while at school, their Individual Health Plan and/or MedA forms will need to be updated for the next school year.

6th Grade Team News




ELA- Choice is so incredibly important to build a lifelong love of reading! To support this, students will be able to select a book of their choice to focus on in the month of May. Students will discuss important passages and ultimately create a book bento as their culminating project for the year! No, they are not creating a lunch, but they will be creating a pictorial representation of the themes in their books to present to the class. (Google “Book Bento” to get an idea of the project!) This is always a fan favorite, and we cannot wait to see all the creativity to come!


Math- For May, students will be finishing up their ratios unit and moving onto our 6th unit: Geometry! This includes finding the area of polygons on and off the coordinate plane, volume, and surface area. *Try it! Find the volume of a rectangular prism if the length is 4 cm, width is 4 cm, and height is 2 cm. Answer: 32 cm³.*

Science- In May we will begin our space unit! We will explore the solar system, investigate gravity, and calculate the mass of objects. We will do experiments with gravity and mass.

Social Studies- Social Studies has wrapped up the Middle Ages and is now into a Podcast Project centered around the Renaissance! Students will be researching various topics and people that brought about European cultural change! We will then be seeing how the Reformation transformed thinking in society and how countries and monarchs set their sights on moving ‘Westward’!



7th Grade Team News



Science: The 7th graders are learning about how their traits are inherited and passed on at the cellular level. The students are applying their knowledge of DNA and genes as they build Punnett Squares to determine the chance that a specific trait gets passed on in the next generation. After this, students will select a genetic disorder to research as well as learn about advances being made in the field of genetics. Finally, we will round out the year in science exploring evidence of how organisms have changed over time.

Social Studies: 7th grade social studies students will be continuing to apply the principles of government that they learned during the Constitution unit to areas of American life. Students will be assessing bias in the news and working to become responsible information consumers. We will also be holding our very own mock Congress and discussing other ways to get involved in government. Throughout the rest of our Civics unit, 7th graders will continue to apply democratic principles to become Americans who contribute to society in a positive and impactful way.



Math: Students will be wrapping up Unit 5 on Percent's the first week in May. Our final unit, Unit 6, will cover Geometry. Students will solve real-life and mathematical problems involving angle measure, area, surface area, and volume. They will also know the formulas for the area and circumference of a circle and use them to solve problems; give an informal derivation of the relationship between the circumference and area of a circle. Finally, they will be able to solve real-world and mathematical problems involving area, volume, and surface area of two- and three-dimensional objects composed of triangles, quadrilaterals, polygons, cubes, and right prisms.

Pre-Algebra: This month in pre-algebra we are finishing up our year with some geometry! We will be working with the Pythagorean theorem and volume! It has been a great year this year! Mrs Netzley and Ms. Jensen are excited to wrap up the year but will miss all the wonderful students!

ELA: We are continuing our Equality Unit, and we will be wrapping up our study of the Civil Rights Movement with our whole-class text, *Getting Away with Murder: The True Story of the Emmett Till Case*. Following that, we will move forward with discussing other groups of people who have faced inequality throughout history. We will be looking at videos, articles, picture books, and a short fictional story to cover these topics. Students should continue reading their self-selected books.


Encore Team News

Greetings from Engineering and the Environment and Introduction to Agriculture. This year has been an adventure for sure. This final quarter having the students back has allowed us to begin more of our hands-on activities. The agriculture students that are in class are growing herbs. They should be bringing those home with them sometime in mid to late May. We also brought African violets back in the school and it is the intention that the students will be repotting and re-planting and bringing home the African violets at the end of the school year. Engineering and the environment students are almost ready to engineer windmill blades. The goal will be to build the most efficient windmill blade to pick up the most weight. They will also be watching a demonstration on series and parallel wiring with electric motors to run a water pump. It is our intention that the last project of the year they will be creating an igloo to protect an ice cube from a heat source. The igloo project will be a first-time adventure for my classroom. 

Thank you to all our families for supporting our efforts at a safe, efficient traffic pattern for the drop-off and pick-up of students. By using the full circular sidewalk in front of the building, we are able to reduce the back-up that has occurred in previous years on Nelser Road. Please make sure that you pull all the way forward around the circular drive and have the students exit your vehicles on the sidewalk-side of your car.
